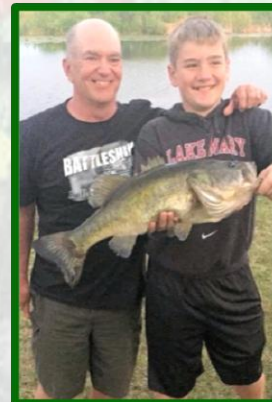
Road Races
